## Parking for Region Rendezvous-Apalachicola

Folks, for the Region Rendezvous in Apalachicola, try to park in public parking places on Water Street, which parallels the Apalachicola River on the east side of town. These places are perpendicular to the River and are not metered. It is marked by the red arrow on the map below and is directly across from the Grady Building (The Consulate Suites) at 76 Water Street. If parking places are not available on Water Street, the Court House parking lot on the east end of Water Street and across Water Street from the River should have available places on a Saturday. This lot is marked by a yellow arrow on the map below. It also is not metered. We will meet at 11:00 AM for a briefing on the day's events at the Flag Pole on Water Street in the park in front of the parking places. Look forward to seeing you there.
